## **To be labeled with your child's name**

- 1 set of headphones or earbuds (the earbud cords tend to tangle easily). Also, if you can find headphones with the straight jack instead of an L shaped jack, the straight jack works better on the iPads.
- Water bottle (no bigger than 16 oz., please)
- Large backpack
- 2 composition books (Plain lined)
- Lunch bag

## **Community supplies—no need to label**

- Glue sticks: 2-4
- Markers: 2 pkg Crayola broad tip (classic colors, please)
- Expo fine tip black dry erase markers: 2 pack or 4 pack
- Expo broad tip black dry erase markers: 2 pack or 4 pack
- 1 or 2 packs of college ruled paper
- 1 or 2 packages of plain pink wedge shaped erasers (not the pencil top)

- Clorox wipes
